


Select [start] - [My Computer] or [Computer] [WALKMAN] - [Storage Media].

4 Follow the on-screen instructions.

- 5 Double-click (WALKMAN Guide) on the desktop to start the WALKMAN



Charging the Battery

The player's battery is recharged while the player is connected to a running computer.




Turning the Player On and Off

turn off	Press and hold the OPTION/PWR OFF button.


How to use the Home menu

The Home menu appears when you press and hold the BACK/ HOME button. The Home menu is the starting point to play audio, search for songs, changing settings, etc.


From the Home menu, you can select the desired item on the screen by using the 5-way button.



To initialize (format) the player

You can format the built-in flash memory of the player. If the memory is formatted, all files including the Operation Guide (PDF file) will be erased and all setting values returned to their defaults. Be sure to verify the files stored in memory prior to formatting, and then export any necessary files to the hard disk of your computer or other device beforehand.

- 1 Press and hold the BACK/HOME button until the Home menu appears.
- 2 Select **[**Settings] [Common Settings] - [Reset/Format] - [Format] -[Yes] - [Yes] in this order.

Press the $\triangle/\nabla/\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ button to select the item, and then press the **I** button to confirm.

When initialization finishes, [Memory formatted.] appears.

• Do not format the built-in flash memory using Windows Explorer, If you format the built-in flash memory, format it on the player.
